

























































FROM THE PUBLISHER'S DESK

Ted Adams here. I'm going to be your monthly guide through the IDW/Top Shelf checklist, pointing out our big hits and bringing your attention to some gems that you might otherwise miss.

Chris Ryall's dream has come true: IDW is publishing

Rom. IDW and Hasbro have been working together on comics for more than a decade and I don't think a week's gone by when Chris hasn't been trying to find a way for us to publish *Rom*.

His dreams came true when we launched *Rom* as part of this year's Free Comic Book Day event and continue in July with the release of the first issue. Chris is joined on writing duties by **Christos Gage** and long-time IDW artist, **David**

Messina, is handling the art. The heavy-hitters providing covers for the first issue include J.H. Williams III, P. Craig Russell, Michael Golden, Sal Buscema, Zach Howard, and Tom Whalen.

July is also Rom cover month at IDW and you'll find him featured on Action Man #2, Back to the Future #10, G.I. Joe: A Real American Hero #230, Jem and the Holograms #17, Judge Dredd #8, Micronauts #4, My Little Pony: Friendship is Magic #44, My Little Pony: Friends Forever #30, Star Trek #59, Transformers #55, Transformers: More Than Meets the Eye #55, and Transformers: Till All Are One #2.

The **Powerpuff Girls** are back in a big way at Cartoon Network with an all-new 40-episode series that premiered in April. We've got a new series, **Powerpuff Girls** #1, that takes place directly in the world of the new show with stories written by show writers **Jake Goldman** and **Haley Mancini** and drawn by **Derek Charm**.

Ask your retailer about the extrarare variant cover by **Jay Hasrajani**, one of the show's animators.

A hidden gem from IDW this month is **Angora Napkin: Cuddle Core Collected Edition**. A 320-page collection of **Troy Little**'s cult-classic, Eisner-Nominated series that includes a DVD with the animated TV show that brings the characters to life.


Flipperboobootosis?! This one also has a rare variant

cover drawn by one of the shows animators, **Tara Billinger**.

EuroComics brings us one of my favorite titles, *Alack Sinner*, by Carlos Sampayo and Jose Muñoz. This is the first of two volumes that will collect, for the first-time in English, all of the Alack Sinner comics by this legendary Argentinian team. Sinner is a hard-boiled private detective whose adventures are played out to a jazz soundtrack in a noir New York from 1975 through the 2000s. This one gets my highest recommendation.


Another one of my favorites is **Bill Sienkiewicz's**The New Mutants: Marvel Artist Select Series. The title is a mouthful but this is the latest in the line of hardcover books we're doing with Marvel. Every copy is signed by Sienkiewicz, comes in a slipcover and is strictly limited to 999 copies. If you've read my other columns, you know that one of my sweet spots for comics is Marvel in the '70s and '80s and there's not much I like more than the issue collected here (New Mutants #'s 18 to 31, as well as, a bonus story by Chris Claremont and Sienkiewicz).

While we're talking about Marvel, this month's Artist's Edition is *Marvel Covers: The Modern Era*. There are two covers to choose from—a Spidey cover by **Todd McFarlane** and a Wolvie cover by **Sam Kieth**. Inside the book you'll find covers by Art Adams, J. Scott Campbell, Jim Lee, Sam Kieth, Todd McFarlane, John Romita, Jr., Joe Quesada, Marc Silvestri, and more.



IDW Games has **Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles: Shadows of the Past**, designed by **Kevin Wilson**.
This is a miniatures combat, scenario-driven campaign game that features story content from the IDW *TMNT* comic. Every game comes with more than 40 sculpted minis, 12 unique maps and over 100 cards featuring all-new art by **Tony Vargas**.
