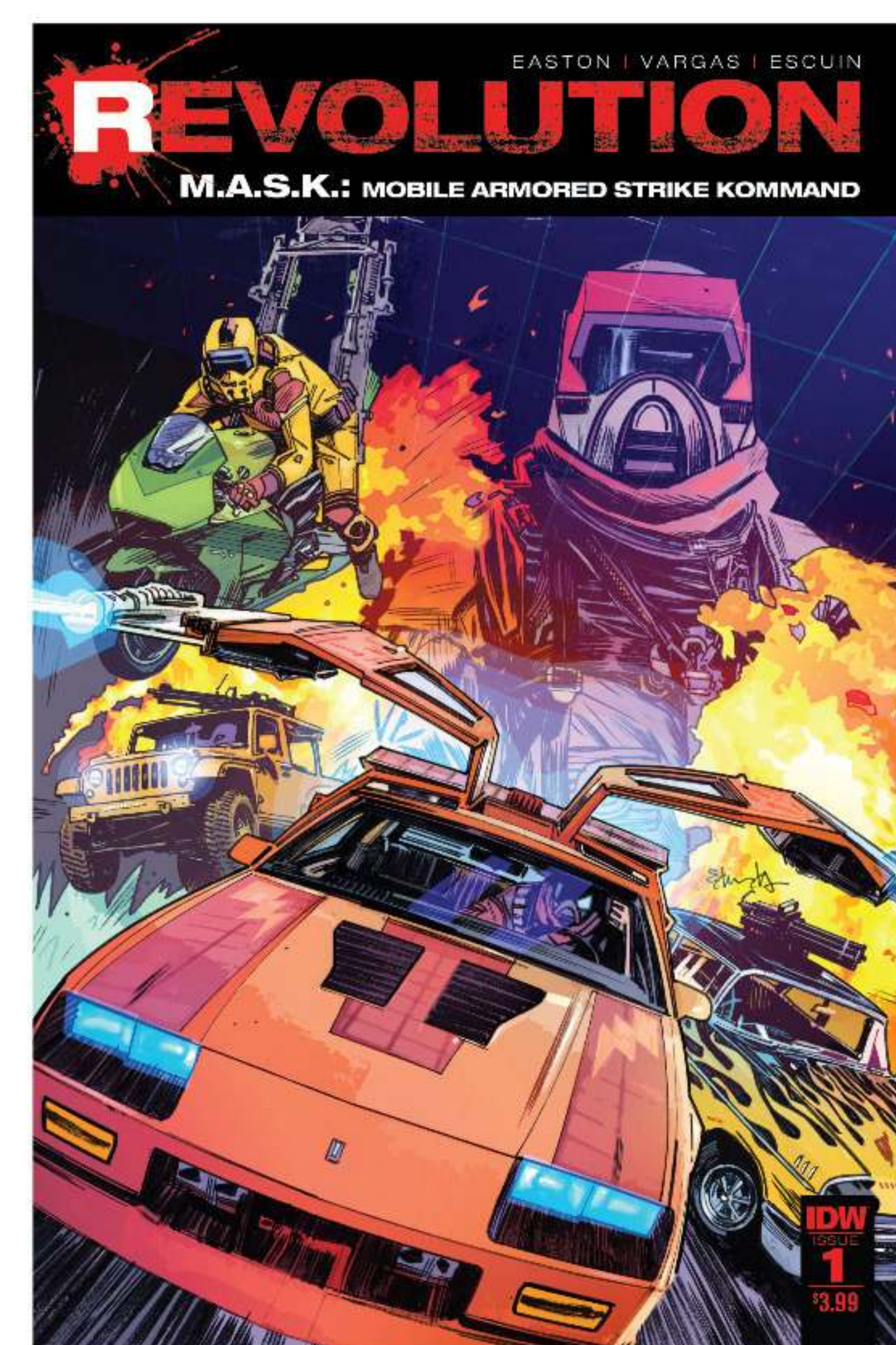
Okay, on to our books, TV shows, and games. We're re-teaming with our friends at DC Comics to bring you **Batman/Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles Adventures #1** by Matthew K. Manning and Jon Sommariva. This all-new series brings the animated versions of these classic characters together for the first time and marks the return of **Batman: The Animated Series** to comics.

Speaking of animated characters, **Donald Quest #1** by Stefano Ambrosio and Pat McGreal find Donald, Mickey and the gang in the steampunk warrior world of Feudarnia.

Our huge **Revolution** event concludes this month and the repercussions will continue to be felt in all of our Hasbro titles. November sees the launch of two new titles

that are part of the new Hasbro shared universe—**Optimus Prime #1** by John Barber and Kei Zama and **M.A.S.K.: MOBILE ARMORED STRIKE KOMMAND** by Brandon Easton and Tony Vargas.

Please check out a new creator-owned book we're launching this month—**Yakuza Demon Killers**, by Amit Chauhan and Eli Powell, where an art thief gets stuck

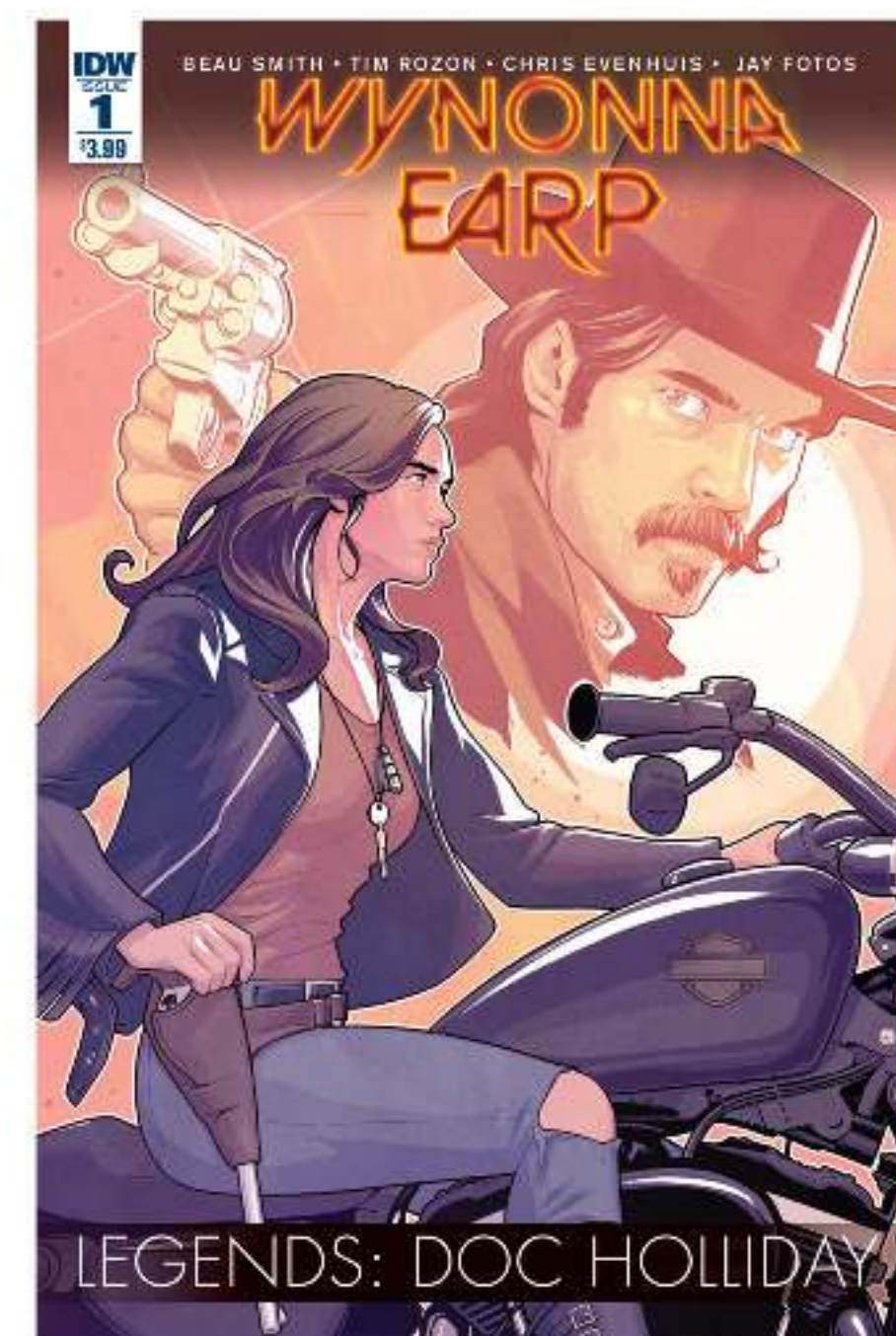


between demons and the Yakuza.

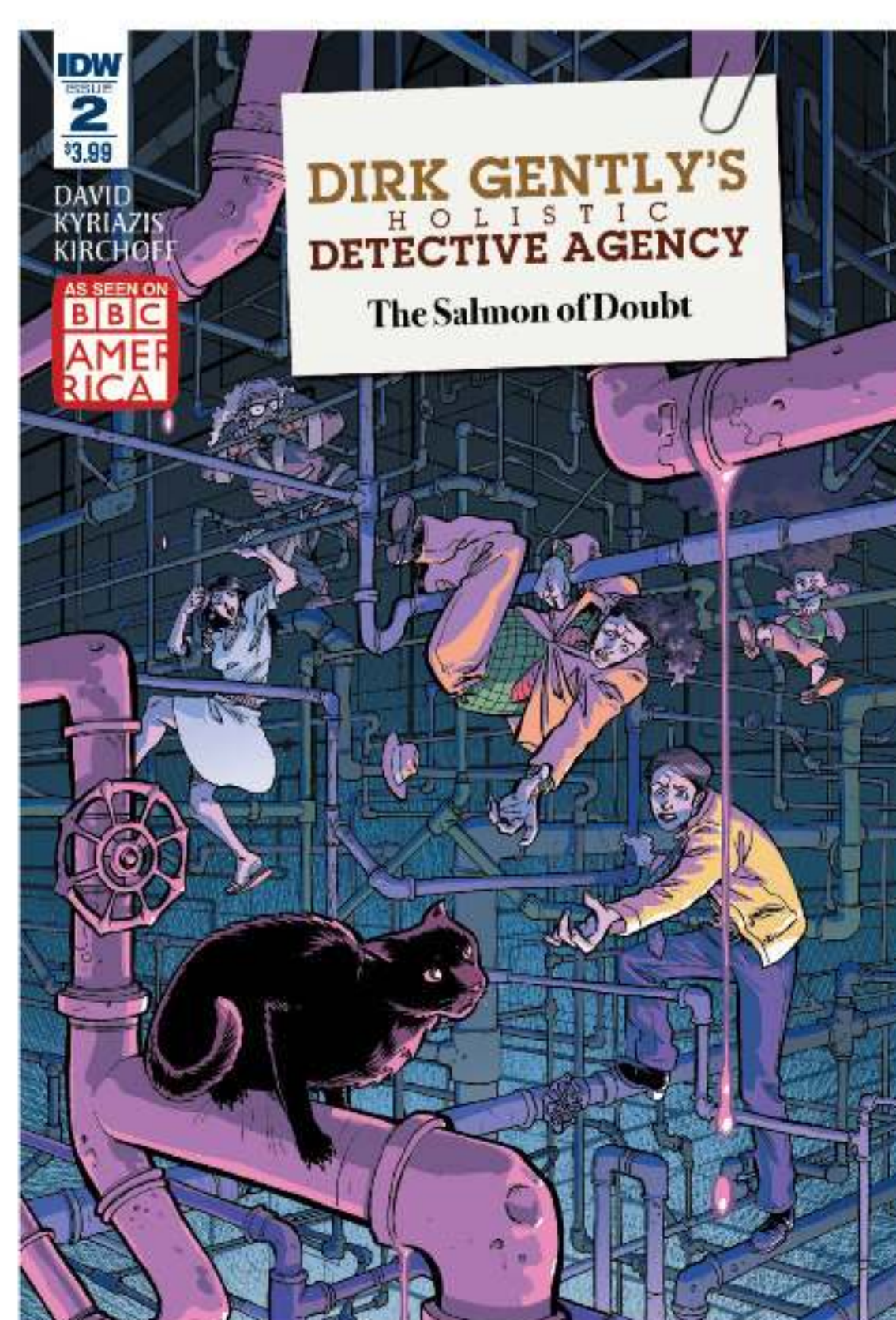
Fred Van Lente and Ryan Dunlavey are taking their terrific **Comic Book History of Comics** graphic novel and are presenting it in full-color and in comic book format for the first time. I'm proud to say I discovered

this book at a C2E2 show in Chicago many years ago and it's been one of my favorite books ever since.

Wynonna Earp creator Beau Smith is joined by the man who plays Doc Holliday himself, Tim Rozon, in **Wynonna Earp Legends: Doc Holliday #1**. You can even ask your retailer how to get a copy autographed by Tim. If you haven't checked out the **Wynonna Earp** TV show, it's available on iTunes and Amazon.



Speaking of IDW Entertainment TV shows, I hope you've had a chance to check out **Dirk Gently's Holistic Detective Agency**—it airs on BBC America on Saturday nights. We produced the show in a partnership with Ideate Media and AMC Studios and it stars Sam Barnett and Elijah Wood. Based on the Douglas Adams books and created for TV by Max Landis, I can guarantee you've never seen anything like it. And while you're at it, make sure to keep an eye out for **Dirk Gently: The Salmon of Doubt #2** by Arvind Ethan David and Ilias Kyriazis which includes characters from the original books and the TV series.



This month's Artist's Edition is **America's Best Comics** with art by Arthur Adams, Hilary Barta, Gene Ha, Kevin Nowlan, Chris Sprouse, Rick Veitch, J.H. Williams III and more. The ABC Line won 12 major Eisner Awards during its run and was created by Alan Moore. This is a who's who of great modern comic artists.
